HISTORY OF CASE (supposed facts to be proven at inquest):
The deceased resided with his wife and four children at 2447-16th Avenue. On the evening of September 25, 1942, the deceased complained of severe pains in the upper left chest. On September 26, 1942 the patient still complained of the pain and remained in bed. About 3:30 PM 9/26/42 Mrs. Giannini went to do some shopping and upon her return home about 5:15 PM found her husband apparently dead in bed. Dr. Collischon was called and upon his arrival at 5:50 PM 9/26/42 pronounced death. The deceased, prior to September 25, 1942 had apparently been in normal health
